### **SCHOLARSHIP**

#### **INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS**

The Don Owens Memorial Lodge #88 annually awards scholarships to graduating seniors of the three Monroe County high schools pursuing a career in Law Enforcement or other Criminal Justice field. Scholarships awarded total \$500.00 for each school and may be used at any approved and accredited College or University in the State of Indiana.

Payment is made directly to the qualifying College or University of choice. Scholastic ability, scholastic achievement, and a 200 word essay are among the criteria used to select recipients. Determination will be made by members of the FOP 88 Scholarship Committee. Applicants will not be interviewed. Awards will be announced by May 28.

Other necessary qualifications include:

1. Minimum Grade Point Average of a B+ (3.3).
2. Submission of high school transcript.
3. Scholarship must be used the fall semester following award.

#### **CHECKLIST FOR A COMPLETE APPLICATION**

1. A completed application form.
2. Official transcript of high school credits, grades, and list of completed subjects.
3. A minimum of three letters of recommendation. Letters should include at least one recommendation from each:
  - a. Teacher, counselor, or administrator.
  - b. Employer or extracurricular activity counselor.
  - c. Personal – someone in a position to know the applicant well.

Items 1 - 3 should be arranged in the given order and then stapled together. Return the completed application to your school counselor no later than **April 30**.
